CALL TO ORDER.

Mayor Bassett called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

I. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

MOTION: Councilor Abrams made a motion to approve the agenda. Councilor Holle seconded the motion.

VOTE: All Councilors voted aye. The motion carried.

II. ACTION ITEMS

Adoption of Town of Edgewood Resolution No. 2020-09: An election resolution calling for a question to be added to a special election to be held on August 24th, 2020 on the question of whether the Town of Edgewood should form as a Commission/Manager Form of Government.

Mayor Bassett announced that Attorney William Zarr made a change to the Resolution language on number 4, which reads "This Resolution supersedes Resolution 2020-16" and added the words, "which is rescinded and repealed."

MOTION: Councilor Abrams made a motion to approve the amended Resolution 2020-09 calling for a special election for the Town of Edgewood, including the addition of the language, "which is rescinded and repealed." Councilor Holle seconded the motion.

Councilor Abraham asked if the date can be moved up and why the date was chosen. Mayor Bassett stated that the Writ of Mandamus laid out the dates and this is the date the Town decided on based on the recommendation of the Attorney and it also allows the public ample time to consider their vote.

Councilor Jaramillo asked why it had to come down to the wire and a Writ having to be filed to remain in compliance with the state statute, as she stated that she has been requesting a meeting

and a Resolution for weeks with no response. Mayor Bassett stated that the Town was waiting to hear back from the Secretary of State for information before moving forward.

VOTE: Councilor Holle voted aye. Councilor Jaramillo voted aye. Councilor Abrams voted aye. Councilor Abraham voted aye. The motion carried.
