

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-37

SIGN ORDINANCE ENFORCEMENT MORATORIUM

WHEREAS, a committee created by the Edgewood Chamber of Commerce has proposed certain changes to the Town of Edgewood Sign Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, proposed sign ordinance amendments were presented during a joint meeting held December 3, 2007 between the Town Council and the Planning and Zoning Commission; and


WHEREAS, it was recommended to form a committee with staff support provided by the Town including legal counsel to recommend changes to the existing sign ordinance or a draft of a new ordinance for consideration by the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, such an ad hoc Sign Ordinance Committee will work diligently to try to complete their assignment within ninety (90) days.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Town of Edgewood hereby imposes a ninety (90) day moratorium on the enforcement of the existing sign ordinance relative to temporary signs and directional off-premises signs.
2. Upon expiration of this moratorium on March 11, 2008 all nonconforming signs shall immediately be removed by the sign owner. Any nonconforming signs remaining after expiration of this moratorium are subject to the fines and penalties in the Town of Edgewood sign ordinance.
