**WHEREAS**, the Town of Edgewood recognizes a need to coordinate action among the departments to maximize visibility safely; and


**WHEREAS**, the State Police and the New Mexico Department of Transportation are being contacted for assistance in traffic control and permitting needs; and

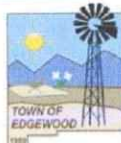

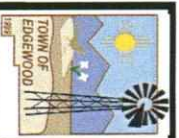

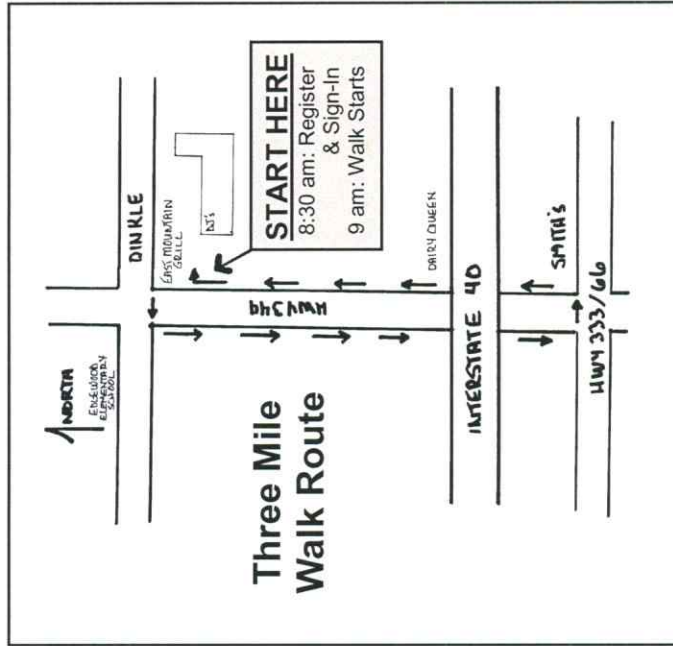

Enjoy views to the North of South Mountain and Northern Edgewood and views to the South of the rolling hills of pinion and juniper trees Edgewood is known for.

The walk begins and ends at the shopping center at the corner of Hwy 344 and Dinkle Road. We will walk South along Hwy 344 to Hwy 333/66, cross Hwy 344 and return heading North on Hwy 344 on our new paths. Approximately a 3 mile walk.

Directions: Take I-40 east to the Edgewood exit 187. Turn North (left) from the exit. Go about one mile to Dinkle. Turn right and right again into the shopping center parking lot. Registration and check-in is in lot in front on DJ's Restaurant.
