

**Resolution No. 2008-42**

**Sign Ordinance Enforcement Moratorium**

**WHEREAS**, a committee created by the Edgewood Chamber of Commerce has proposed certain changes to the Town of Edgewood Sign Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, proposed sign ordinance amendments were presented during a joint meeting held December 3, 2007 between the Town Council and the Planning and Zoning Commission; and


**WHEREAS**, it was recommended to form a committee with staff support provided by the Town including legal counsel to recommend a specific sign ordinance or a draft of a new ordinance for consideration by the Town Council; and

**WHEREAS**, such an Ad-Hoc Sign Ordinance Committee will work diligently to try to complete their assignment within six (6) months.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The Town of Edgewood hereby imposes a six month (6) moratorium on the enforcement of the existing sign ordinance relative to non conforming signs, temporary signs and directional off-premises signs.
2. Any nonconforming signs remaining after expiration of this moratorium will be subject to the Town of Edgewood Sign Ordinance.
3. Temporary signs in public right-of-way are exempt from the moratorium.
