A Resolution to bring Bond issues before the voters

Whereas the present economic conditions make it necessary to boost our general welfare by economic stimulation from within our community.

Whereas the State of New Mexico has allocated funding for projects which should be utilized.

Whereas the community has asked repeatedly, over many years, for various facilities and services without an opportunity to assess the value and vote upon each issue according to personal choice and direct the priorities of the community.

Whereas the economic development of the town of Edgewood is waiting for the completion of collection lines for the sewer treatment plant. The expansion of sewer lines will promote more business growth and improve the health and welfare of the community.

Whereas the improvement and maintenance of roads will not continue keeping pace with use levels and will require funds for any further improvement or development.

Whereas there is a need for construction to house Town offices, Library, Police department, multi-use areas, and common meeting spaces for the community, which has been proposed and for which design monies have been granted by the state.

Whereas there is a recognized need for recreation areas and sports facilities to be built and maintained for the use of our citizens and their children to promote health and fitness.

Whereas the community has expressed a desire to create or expand trails for recreational activities and low speed transportation via foot, horseback, or bicycle.

Whereas each community members voice should be heard in setting the direction of our community.

Whereas the voice of the Town of Edgewood is it's people.

Whereas the voice of Edgewood needs to be heard through the ballot box to make or deny a commitment to community projects.

Whereas it must be decided which project(s) is(are) to proceed, by mandate, initiating the process for the Town of Edgewood to secure funds which will achieve both a short term economic boost and meet the communities long term goals and needs.


Resolution No. 2009-27 (con't)

Now Therefore be it Resolved that the intent of the Council of the Town of Edgewood is to bring before the voters a set of Bond Issues, at the earliest reasonable date, to finance and build those public projects and services for which design funding has been allocated by the State or which the Town has planned and promised for many years.

1. Road Construction and improvements
2. The construction of a multipurpose municipal facility (on Section 16).
3. Recreational Facilities – playing field expansion (on Section 16).
4. Trail improvement.


The bonding issues to be brought before the voters shall be scaled to meet the communities needs and the vote shall determine the priority by the will of the community how we build our community and stimulate our own economic condition by creating jobs, building lasting community works, and improving service within our community.
