

Resolution No. 2009-29

**A budget resolution to fund installation of wind generation
Equipment for Town Offices**

Whereas the Town of Edgewood can make a public commitment to renewable and sustainable energy.

Whereas the Town will see a reduction in a portion of the Towns energy expense which will in time repay this investment and reduce the Towns reoccurring energy expenses.

Whereas renewable energy will benefit taxpayers by allowing monies not spent on utility bills to be utilized for other purposes.

Whereas the Town of Edgewood should provide leadership for the community by setting a visible example.

Whereas by making an investment in renewable energy the Town of Edgewood through its commitment will give notice that our community is behind State and Federal initiatives to reduce dependence on fossil fuels and improve our environment through use of renewable resources.

Whereas the Town of Edgewood has enshrined the windmill as an element in the Towns logo it therefore follows that we should utilize a windmill to power our Towns seat of government.


Therefore be it resolved that a budget adjustment be made to set aside funds in the amount of twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) for the purchase and construction of a wind generator on a fixed monopole to be located on the grounds of the current Town Offices and that a draft bid package be prepared by Staff and brought before Council for review within (30) days of the passage of this resolution.
