Timeline

July 27th: Last day to register to vote to vote in the Special Election



July 28th – July 30th: Ballots will be sent out by the Santa Fe County Clerk to all registered voters. *Please do not throw away the ballot or mistake it for junk mail.*

If you are a registered voter and do not receive a ballot by August 10th please contact the Santa Fe County Clerk's Office at 505-986-6280

August 24th: Special Election Day: This is the day on which all ballots will be tallied after 7:00 pm. Your ballot must be received by the Santa Fe County Clerk prior to 7:00 pm on this day.

If you have not or do not want to mail in your ballot it can also be dropped off at the Office of the Santa Fe County Clerk during regular business hours unless the day is August 24th, in which case it can be dropped off before 7:00 pm.
