LIBRARIAN REPORT April 2012

The Library has had a fairly busy month. Andrea delivered postcards for the Summer Reading Program to the area schools. The postcards are also being placed in patron's books to remind them that the summer is near, and the program is here! The library carpets were cleaned on the second of April, and Andrea's husband kindly came in to hang the shelving for the Juvenile Graphic Novel section. Also hung at the same time were literature holders, in the front under the window, which cleaned up the table! They all look nice, and will be very useful to have. This month we also celebrated Volunteer Appreciation Week. A cake was ordered from Smith's, and ice cream bought, to thank our volunteer's for all of the hard work they put in for us, consistently. Thank you all, we could not do this without each and every one of you, and your dedication to the library!

April was the first full month for new Assistant librarian, Barbara Hambek. She was certified in CPR and First Aid on April 5, 2012. This is a challenging but fun job, and she is looking forward to many more months (and years?) to come. One of the challenging moments was when Andrea went on maternity leave (starting April 16, 2012), and Barb was left in charge. Andrea had a baby girl, Saturday, April 14, after her last day in the library on Friday the 13th. When it is available, the patrons will be able to access the library catalog from their mobile devices, such as iphones, laptops, mobile phones, tablets, etc.
