AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THE PETITION BY OWNERS OF A MAJORITY OF 40 ACRES OF TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO THE WEST BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF EDGEWOOD, NEW MEXICO TO ANNEX THE TERRITORY.

WHEREAS; THE TOWN OF EDGEWOOD owners of a majority of 40 acres of territory contiguous to the current west boundaries of the Town of Edgewood petition the Town to annex the territory; and

WHEREAS, the annexation petition delivered to the Town Clerk complies with the requirements of NMSA 1978, S3-7-17 (Repl. Pamp 1987) and was, prior to signature by petitioners, duly approved by the Town Clerk, pursuant to NMSA 1978, S3-1-5 (Repl. Pamp. 1987) and

WHEREAS, in particular, the annexation petition is accompanied by two maps labeled Exhibits "A" and "B" showing respectively the external boundary of the territory proposed to be annexed and the relationship of such territory to the existing Town boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Edgewood has determined that the Town is capable of providing municipal services to the territory proposed to be annexed within a reasonable time and that the annexation is in the best interests of the Town as a whole.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF EDGEWOOD THAT:

The territory described and defined in the maps attached hereto as Exhibits "A" and "B" is hereby annexed to the Town of Edgewood and is hereby made subject to all of the laws and ordinances which shall now or hereafter apply to land within the Town limits. Further, the Council hereby directs the Town Clerk to file a copy of the map of the annexed territory in the office of the Clerk of Santa Fe County and of any other County in the event the annexed territory extends into another County and to send copies of the ordinance and of the maps of the territory so annexed to the Secretary of Finance and Administration and to the Secretary of Taxation and Revenue.

Motion that the discussion for Commercial sign limitations be tabled and that it the aforesaid definition for sign face be recognized as a working definition. Further, the commissioners request that this change be held back at this time to allow Mr. Leyba more time to submit suggestions about the Commercial Sign limitations of the ordinance.

PUBLIC **HEARINGS:**

ZONING MAP

P&Z had recommended the NW part of Section 24, Lands of Stan Huston be zoned CB. Discussion ensued as to merits of CB or SU designation. P & Z preferred CB because of commercial sales aspect of Mr. Huston's operation. Staff explained that commercial sales are inherent in any manufacturing or processing operation, therefore the SU-5 designation is appropriate. Also, the SU-5 designation would prevent the expansion of other types of commercial businesses into this part of town without further review. Council approved SU-5 designation. Howard Calkins made motion and Councilor Chemistrick seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.

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ANNEX: 40 ACRES

Comments were taken from the public regarding the annexation of 40 acres within Section 16. Councilor Calkins made a motion to accept annexation and Bob Stearley seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.

REPORTS:

Parks & Rec Parks & Recreation Chairman, Dennis Milinazzo, reported there would be no summer program this year because of the very short notice from SF county. He feels there was not enough time for the Town to prepare for a safe and quality program for the area children at this time. He assures residents that plans and programs for the next year are already being worked on.

Health Clinic Chuck Ring reported that the steering committee is still trying to obtain funding for a health clinic.

The Mayor, Chuck Ring and Kelly Moe will travel to Portales June 13, to visit some health care facilities there.

Animal Control

Roads

Marina Doerfer was guest speaker. She gave some tips on how to peacefully resolve problems with stray dogs and irresponsible pet owners.

Councilor Stearley presented an ordinance regarding Animal Control used by Town of Estancia, for consideration by the Town of Edgewood. No action was taken on the ordinance at this time.

Gary Chemistruck reported that on June 8, STIP will meet to plan projects for the next couple of years. Regarding Section 16, Mr. Stearley recommended that part of the cost turning lanes off of State Road 344 be passed on to master developers and contractors. The Mayor plans to meet with Dr. Stowe and Mr. Manning to discuss matters that would be to the best interest and safety of the most important issue-the children. Comment was made that Mike Hoy and his road crew are doing an excellent job despite limited equipment.

Town Celebration

Frank Lasky reported teams are working around the clock, meeting 2 to 3 times a week, to finalize plans. Have quite a number of businesses participating in the event. Rich Ford is paying for three weeks of advertising prior to the celebration.
