

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-8

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for local governments and Tribal governments to join together to cooperatively resolve area-wide problems, including but not limited to water and sewers, land uses and open spaces, and transportation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that coordinated development through effective regional Planning within the New Mexico State Planning and Development District 3, as defined on the attached map, occurs in order to promote the general health, welfare, convenience, and prosperity of the people in that area; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive regional planning program would facilitate coordinated development within the four counties comprising New Mexico State Planning and Development District 3, and

WHEREAS, the **TOWN OF EDGEWOOD** hereby elects to become a member of the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE **TOWN OF EDGEWOOD**, NEW MEXICO THAT:

1. The governing body of the **TOWN OF EDGEWOOD** hereby joins with the several local governments and Tribal Governments within the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments of New Mexico and does adopt, along with those several governments, the Articles of Agreement which govern the functions and operations of the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments. A copy of those Articles, as originally executed by the original parties on the 19th day of June, 1967 and subsequently amended by the voting membership is attached and made part of this resolution.
2. By the **TOWN OF EDGEWOOD** becoming a member of the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments, the governing body of the **TOWN OF EDGEWOOD** will, by resolution, appoint a representative of the governing body to membership on the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments Board of Directors, and will also appoint a designated alternate for the appointed representative. By this action, the appointed representative is authorized to execute the vote of the **TOWN OF EDGEWOOD** in any considered appropriate and taken by the Board of Directors of the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments of New Mexico on behalf of the collective body of general and special purpose units of government acting in concert within New Mexico State Planning and Development District 3.
