THE NEW MEXICO STATE HIGHWAY & TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the municipality of Edgewood has adopted a Comprehensive Plan which outlines necessary capital improvements for the Town, including various transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department (NMSHTD) has already assumed lead responsibility to analyze, plan, and develop a new Interchange in Edgewood at the intersection of I-40 and NM344; and

WHEREAS, the officials and staff of the Town of Edgewood have reviewed the report of the Second Public Information Meeting which was held regarding the proposed new interchange in Edgewood;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF EDGEWOOD, that:

The Town of Edgewood supports the Single Point Interchange Alternative as being the most beneficial alternative for the proposed new interchange in Edgewood at the intersection of I-40 and NM344.
