**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EDGEWOOD, NEW MEXICO
SUPPORTING A WILDLIFE SAFE PASSAGE UNDER INTERSTATE 40
AND HWY 333/66**

WHEREAS, the Town of Edgewood is dedicated to the safe passage of wildlife and reduction of wildlife-vehicle collisions; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Edgewood recognizes that collisions due to hitting or avoiding wildlife on highways present a problem resulting in injuries, deaths and property damage; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Edgewood recognizes that wildlife safe passage Ecopassages for wildlife connect habitat and reduce dangerous accidents involving vehicles and animals; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Edgewood recognizes the need to coordinate action with the Tijeras Canyon Safe Passage Coalition, New Mexico Department of Transportation and Santa Fe County to implement a wildlife safe passage; and
