

**TOWN OF EDGEWOOD**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-02**  
**Clarifying the Town's Position regarding the proposed**  
**Field Their Dream Sports Complex**  
**and the approved ICIP**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Edgewood recently retained JNC Associates to lobby the New Mexico State Legislature on behalf of the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor and Town Administrator met with JNC Associates to provide direction consistent with policies adopted by the governing body; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 15, 2007 the Governing Body approved resolution 2007-28 which identified the top 5 priorities in the Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan (ICIP): (*i.e.*, (1) Wastewater Collection System, (2) Public Works Facility, (3) Regional Animal Shelter (4) Sec 16 Access Road (5) Community Center/Library); and

**WHEREAS**, regional recreation fields are listed in the ICIP, but not as a ranked priority project, and


**WHEREAS**, Individuals and groups have every right to seek support from their elected state officials for various causes and/or projects and the municipal corporation of Edgewood is just one more constituent in this process; and

**WHEREAS**, Advocating for Town priorities before the Legislature and Governor does not, directly or indirectly, imply opposition to any other Edgewood area project.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The Town of Edgewood's support for the Field Their Dreams Sports Complex is unchanged.
2. Directing the Town's lobbyist to pursue wastewater collection system grant funds and regional animal shelter grant funds is consistent with the approved ICIP.
