

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-18

Priority Roadway Improvements

Whereas, the Town of Edgewood, in part, was incorporated to provide better roads in the area

Whereas, the town of Edgewood has surveyed traffic volume, housing density, and has made other considerations to identify and classify road use for several years

Whereas, the 2010 US Census has shown a marked population increase in the area

Whereas, citizens of the Town of Edgewood have petitioned for road work to be done

Whereas, the Town of Edgewood is committed to the health, safety and welfare of its citizens

Whereas, three roadway sections of the Town of Edgewood have been identified as in immediate need of hard road surfacing due to factors which include traffic volume, dust, visibility, maintenance requirements, patterns of use, and citizens served

Williams Ranch Road, in the east area

West Hill Ranch Road, in the northern area

Moriarty Road/Duke/Willard Road, in the southern area

Therefore Be It Resolved:

that based upon the data collected and other factors, that priority be set for pavement of roadways as identified to date with a chip seal process as soon as feasible.


That the funding for this preliminary project to be budgeted accordingly by council upon receipt of winning bid proposals and that funds remaining from the initial allocation be dedicated to the next roadway by priority, information be published as it becomes available.
