

**TOWN OF EDGEWOOD  
RESOLUTION NO. 2012-05**

***A Resolution to Establish an Intergovernmental Agreement between  
Santa Fe County and the Town of Edgewood for Road Maintenance Issues.***

***Whereas***, the County of Santa Fe is responsible for providing road maintenance to all Santa Fe County roads as identified by the certified Santa Fe County Road Map; and

***Whereas***, the Town of Edgewood is responsible for providing road maintenance to all of the Town of Edgewood's roads as identified by the certified Town of Edgewood's Road Map; and

***Whereas***, both the County and the Town are spread out geographically containing numerous square miles of area; and


***Whereas***, both the County and the Town are responsible for maintaining public roads traversing large areas that tend to extend to the far reaches for the respective entity and are costly to approach and maintain; and

***Whereas***, some public roads maintained by the County and the Town tend to be located in areas where it is more cost effective for the neighboring entity to approach and maintain; and


***Whereas***, this situation lends itself to the County of Santa Fe and the Town of Edgewood to consider formulating a Intergovernmental Agreement that would allow the County and the Town to work on road maintenance issues.

***Now Therefore Be It Resolved***, that the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners and the Town of Edgewood approve this Resolution and authorize the Public Works Departments, to formulate an Intergovernmental Government Agreement with the Town of Edgewood, that list the public roads to be maintained by the respective entity.
