**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN (ICIP)**

**WHEREAS**, in times of scarce resources, it is necessary to find new financing mechanisms and maximize the use of existing resources; and



**WHEREAS**, this process contributes to local and regional efforts in project identification and selection in short and long range capital planning efforts.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF EDGEWOOD that:**
