**A RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION MUNICIPAL ARTERIAL PROGRAM FOR THE
RECONSTRUCTION OF CHURCH ROAD WITHIN THE TOWN OF EDGEWOOD,
NEW MEXICO.**

WHEREAS: The Town of Edgewood, New Mexico is a municipal corporation, acting by its Town Council, in support of participating in the planning, design, construction, reconstruction and construction observation of Church Road between Quail Trail and Williams Ranch Road and;

PASSED, APPROVED and ADOPTED this 20th day of FEBRUARY, 2013.

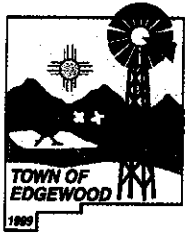
