## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-07**

## A RESOLUTION REGARDING PUBLIC USE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE EDGEWOOD BACHELOR DRAW PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND TRAIL

WHEREAS, the Town of Edgewood ("Town") is a municipal organization duly organized and existing as a municipal corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Edgewood Council is the duly recognized governing body acting with authority for the Town and responsible for the exercise of its governmental powers; and

WHEREAS, the Town has received Federal Funds from the Transportation Alternative Program ("TAP"), Control No. 5101330 under the New Mexico Department of Transportation ("NMDOT") for the Edgewood Bachelor Draw Pedestrian Bridge ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, receipt of the TAP Funds requires that the project must be dedicated and open for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Edgewood has completed design of the Project from New Mexico State Road 344 to Municipal Way; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Edgewood has identified the real property interests necessary for the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Right of Way maps for the Project identify a Construction Maintenance Easement located on property owned by the Town, which property is identified as Parcel 3-CME-1 and which is depicted in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Parcel 3-CME-1 is owned by the Town but not currently designated as existing Town right-of-way and there is a need to confirm that the trail facility constructed under this Project will be open for use by the public as Town right-of-way;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town of Edgewood Council as follows: 1. The Town hereby confirms the Town property upon which the Project is constructed shall be dedicated for public use; and 2. Parcel 3-CME-1, which property is depicted on Exhibit A, shall be dedicated as public right-of-way.
