**WHEN TO FLY THE POW/MIA FLAG**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body seeks to designate recognized days to fly the flag of those whom are or have been prisoners of war and those missing in action during combat.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF EDGEWOOD, NEW MEXICO:**

**Section 1.** The following six national days will be designated to fly the POW/MIA flag according to the 1998 Defense Authorization act. The Governing Body and Town Manager may at their discretion add additional days for flying the MIA/POW flag.:

- Armed Forces Day—Third Saturday in May
- Memorial Day—Last Monday in May
- Flag Day—June 14
- Independence Day—July 4
- National POW/MIA Recognition Day—Third Friday in September
- Veterans Day—November 11

**Section 2.** The Town Manager is authorized to take any action necessary to carry out the directives of this Resolution.
